

Lodgement of paper work and late fees

As from 1 August 2021: if paperwork is received for Registrations, Transfers, Breeding Returns but no payment is received (by cheque, direct deposit or provision of current credit card details), the paperwork is not lodged. When payment is received that is the date of lodgement, late fees are applicable.

Refer to Rule 9, page 19 of the current Rule Book.

Breeding Returns

No mare names provided & / or no breed dates & / or no signature but payment provided – This is not lodged correctly and cannot be processed. If a credit card was provided, payment is not to be processed.

The date that the correct paperwork is provided with payment, is the date the appropriate fee is to be charged, meaning late fees are applicable.

If we receive an incomplete breeding return we are able to give a two week grace period as long as it is in writing with the date details / payment is required by before fees increase.

Registration Applications

Same rules applies as Breeding returns – the exception being if the horses name is missing the rego can still be started.

Generic Registration Applications

The lodgement of breeding returns are the responsibility of the Stallion owner. If the person applying for the registration has provide everything required, including payment, then the date the Generic Rego application is received, is the applicable fee.
