## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

In making this application, I agree to abide by all instructions and conditions imposed by Tamworth Regional Council and acknowledge the following information:

- 1. The *roaming entertainer permit* must be displayed in a prominent position by the applicant and must be produced upon request to an officer of Council.
- 2. Tamworth Regional Council accepts NO responsibility for the security and or any loss or damages incurred to roaming entertainers during the Tamworth Country Music Festival.
- 3. The holder of any approval is responsible for the collection and disposal of litter associated with, and in the immediate vicinity of the activity.
- 4. The travel of any pedestrians is not to be impeded.
- 5. No damage is to be done to Council roads, footpaths, property, etc.
- 6. Sound levels are not to exceed 80db. Non compliance will result in a strike being recorded against the entertainer.
- 7. Authorised officers of the Tamworth Regional Council may at any time request the roaming entertainer to cease their activity if the officer is of the opinion that the activity is causing public inconvenience or is likely to cause harm to the public or property. The busker must immediately comply with such as request.
- 8. In the event of a total fire ban no fire use will be permitted as part of the performance.
- 9. Roaming entertainment is not permitted between 1 am and 8 am.
- 10. Vehicle access into the road closure is prohibited for roaming entertainers. Golf carts will be available to assist with carrying or gear into the festival precinct. Further information regarding this will be provided closer to the festival.
- 11. The applicant must hold a current public liability policy of not less than \$20 million, with council listed as an interested party
- 12. I/we indemnify Tamworth Regional Council and its employees and volunteers against any and all liabilities, claims and actions that may eventuate from proving roaming entertainment /busking during the 2019 Tamworth Country Music Festival, Friday 18 January to Sunday 27 January 2019.

In the event of not complying with the terms and conditions above, I acknowledge that Council reserves the right to take immediate action to seek compliance with the conditions of approval or that I may be stopped from trading and be asked to vacate the site by Tamworth Regional Council.
