What your child is learning:

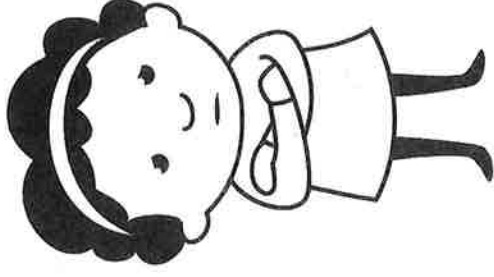
